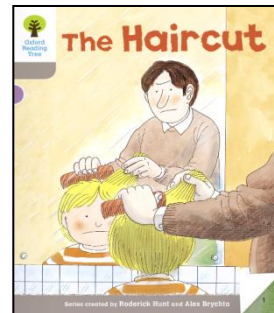
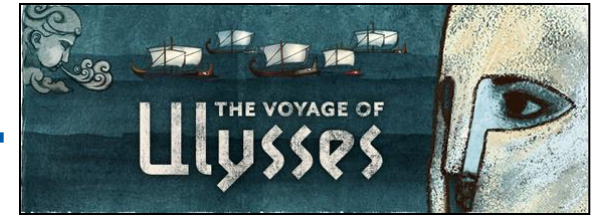
Enhanced eBooks

- new digital publications that allow easy integration of video, audio, interactive features and multimodal content
- more than a simple e-book but not necessarily an app, enhanced e-books (EEB) are a challenge for book marketers, who are not always sure that consumers want or use the extra content or even understand the difference

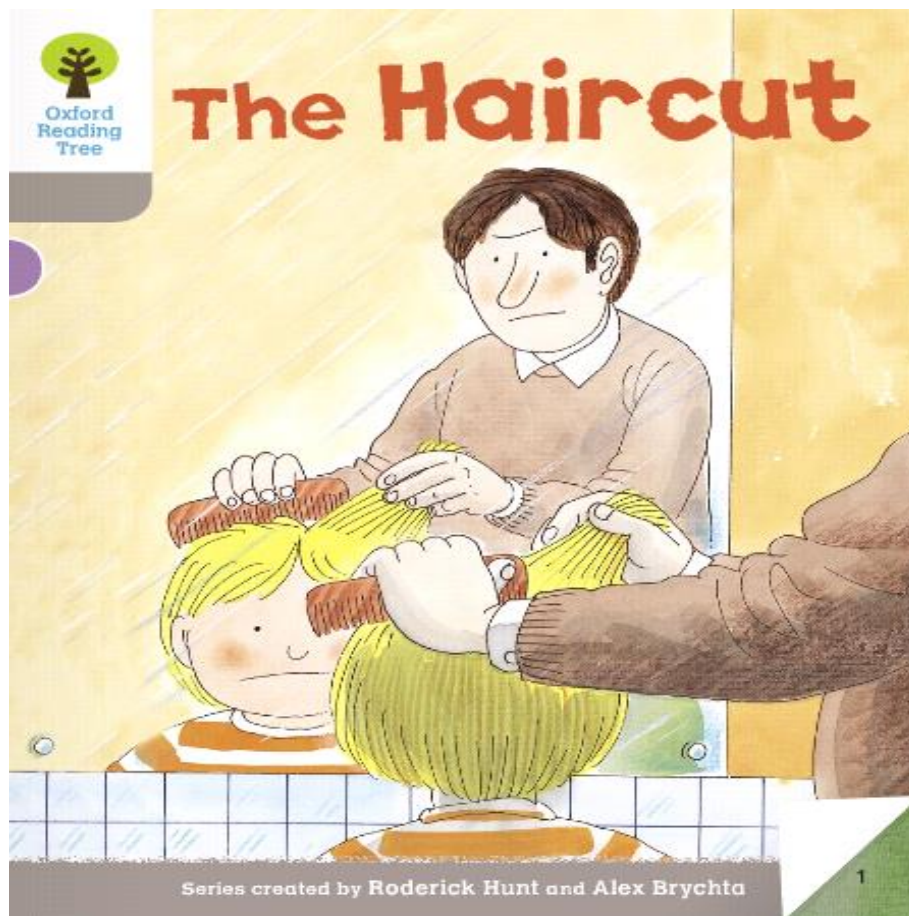

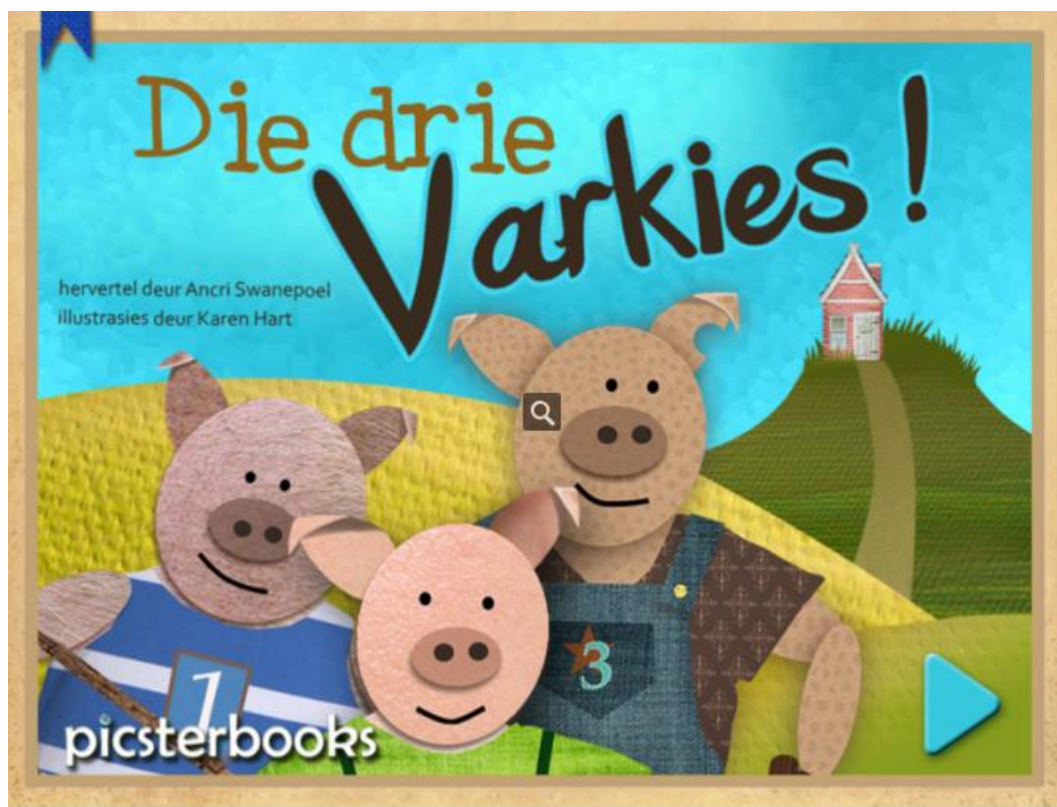
